1. Data Hub

1.1 Economic Data

Access **+45.5 million** data records for **+56,000** key economic and financial data indicators.

AFED aggregates macroeconomic data primarily from local sources into one data platform. In addition, there is also access to international and regional sources.

There are indicators published as soon as they become available and often with several sources, thus giving the client the choice of which sources to use.

The data is reported as published by the source and categorized into **13 main groups** to enable quick and easy access to specific data points:
